

DRESS CODE

Skycrest Christian School has mandatory, uniformed clothing for students in all grades. A variety is available to give flexibility to the students. All uniform apparel must be purchased from the uniform supplier. Our supplier is Risse Brothers, 1710 N. Hercules Ave. Unit 111 Clearwater, Florida 33765, (727) 448-0357. **Uniforms may also be purchased online at www.rissebrothers.com.**

Skycrest reserves the right to require students to comply with the dress code. If students fail to meet these set standards (i.e. non-uniform clothing, etc.) the school will require them to call home for different clothes, or clothing from the uniform closet will be used. The decision of the administration is final, and time spent out of class will be considered unexcused. If the infraction is not corrected, administrative action will be taken. **If a student wears an article of clothing after being told that the article is not permitted, it will result in an automatic office referral and will be subject to the discipline of the referral. The parents will be required to bring the student appropriate clothing.**

The intent of the dress code is to give general overall guidelines to be adhered to by students and parents. Sometimes new situations or circumstances will occur that are not covered specifically by the dress code. The administration has the final word in all dress code matters.

The dress code is in effect from the time of arrival at school until 3:30 p.m. Exception: Students involved in after school sports may change immediately after school is dismissed. Students having P.E. at the end of the day and are involved in sports directly after school may wear P.E. uniforms to homeroom for school dismissal.

All Students

Teachers have the right to ask any student to make adjustments to their present dress in order to conform to the dress standards of SCS. Failure to comply will result in a conduct mark.

Sweaters*	White, navy or red for wear in classroom as needed.
Sweatshirts**	School sweatshirts may be worn in the classroom and chapel during colder weather (55 degrees or lower at 7:00 a.m.). The navy or hooded gray must be ordered through the school office. Non-Skycrest sweatshirts may be worn but must not have offensive language or images.
School Jacket*	Fleece w/Logo-must be purchased from Risse Brothers and can be worn inside the classroom and chapel during colder weather.
Coats/Jackets*	Jackets should only be worn during cold weather. Cold weather is defined as 55 degrees or below at 7:00 a.m. Jackets must not have offensive language or images. All outer wear should be worn properly, not tied around the waist or neck.
Turtleneck Shirts*	May be worn on cold days (55° or below) under uniform shirt. They must be red, white, black, gray, or blue.
P.E. Uniforms**	Shirts and shorts must be purchased at school.

(5th-8th)	Navy sweatpants (purchased elsewhere) may be worn on cold days (55° or below at 7:00 a.m.). There are no exceptions to the P.E. uniform policy.
Socks/Shoes**	Shoes and socks must be worn at all times. Shoes must have back support. Roller shoes, flip flops, or crocs may not be worn.
School T-shirts	Purchased through SCS office--may be worn on Fridays and field trips.
Accessories	Must be non-offensive and in good taste.

All Boys

Hair needs to be neatly trimmed, combed, off the collar, no longer than the bottom of the ear (ear lobe must be visible), and above the eyebrows. Earrings or body piercing are not permitted. Tattoos are not permitted. No extremes in hairstyles or jewelry will be permitted. No extreme bleaching or coloring of the hair is permitted. Undergarments are not to be visible. Extremes will be defined by the administration.

Boys: K4 - 5th

Pants	Navy or gray may be worn on any day.
Shorts	Navy or gray may be worn on any day.
Shirts	Knit (white, light blue, or red) must be tucked in if longer than approximately seven (7) inches from the waist and should have the school logo.

Boys: 6th - 8th

Pants	Navy or khaki may be worn on any day.
Shorts	Navy or khaki may be worn on any day.
Shirts	Knit (white, light blue, navy, or red) must be tucked in if longer than approximately seven (7) inches from the waist and should have the school logo.

All Girls

Jewelry should be kept at a minimum. Tattoos or body piercing are not permitted. No extremes in hairstyles, jewelry, or makeup will be permitted. No extreme bleaching or coloring of the hair is permitted. Extremes will be defined by the administration. All shirts must be long enough to wear past the waist of uniform clothing. Undergarments are not to be visible.

Girls: K4-5th

Jumpers	Navy or plaid, no shorter than four inches above floor when kneeling—for modesty
(K4-3rd)	shorts may be worn underneath, but must be purchased at school.

Pants	Navy may be worn on any day.
P.E. shorts (K4-5th)	Blue P.E. shorts worn under jumpers or skirts must be purchased through school office for K4-4 th . School walking shorts may be worn for P.E. for K4-4 th . 5 th grade must dress out for P.E.
Shirts	Knit (white, light blue, or red) must be tucked in if longer than approximately seven (7) inches from the waist and should have the school logo. Cotton with Peter Pan collar (white or blue, long- or short-sleeved) for grades K4-4 th only.
Skirts*** (4th-5th)	Only "Kickpleat" skirts are allowed. Knifepleat (pleated/lamp shade) skirts are no longer permitted.
Shorts	Navy may be worn on any day.
Culottes (K4-5th)	Plaid
Skorts	Plaid
<u>Girls: 6th-8th</u>	
Capri's	Khaki may be worn on any day. Capri's must be worn at the waist.
Pants	Navy or khaki may be worn on any day.
Shirts	Knit (white, light blue, navy, or red) must be tucked in if longer than approximately seven (7) inches from the waist and should have the school logo.
Shorts	Navy or khaki may be worn on any day. The length must be mid-thigh or longer.
Skorts	Plaid
Skirts***	Only "Kickpleat" skirts are allowed. Knifepleat (pleated/lamp shade) skirts are no longer permitted.

***Optional, but must be purchased through uniform supplier**

****Not necessary to purchase through uniform supplier**

*****The design of the approved skirt has been changed. Students are no longer allowed to wear the "old style" Knifepleat (pleated/lamp shade skirt) this school year. Skorts will be permitted. Please remember that skirts (Kickpleat) and skorts can be no shorter than 4 inches above the floor when kneeling. Violations will be as follows:**

1st offense—Warning

2nd offense—Student will remain in the office until parent can bring an acceptable change of clothes.

3rd offense—Student will no longer be allowed to wear skorts or the skirts.
